Upcoming Training

Cub Scout Roundtable will be held on Thursday, April 1st at 7:30 at the Brooklyn Park LDS Church at 86th and Noble.

Roundtables are held the first Thursday of each month

Cub Scout Leader Training will be on Saturday, April 3rd, 8:15AM to 1:30PM. It is held at Osseo American Legion. The cost is \$15, which the pack will pay. Partial position specific sessions are \$3.

Youth Protection Training will be on April 20th, TBA. This course is free. This course is STRONGLY encouraged for all leaders every 2 years.

Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO) will be held Saturday, April 24th. The day begins at 7AM and runs until 3:30PM. It is held at Rum River Scout Camp. The BSA requires that dens going on a den campout have at least 1 BALOO trained adult with them. (This is not needed for a camp put on by the Viking Council)

Webelos Outdoor Leader Training will be Saturday, April 24th starting at 8:30AM and runs until Noon on Sunday, April 25th. This is held at Stearns Scout Camp. Registration must be in by April 5th. (A person with this training also qualifies as a BALOO trained leader.)


Webelos Camp Health forms and final payment for scouts and adult leaders planning to attend this camp need to be received by the scouting office by May 7th. See your Den leader for more information.
